Use a Network Pharmacy

Your doctor has just given you a prescription. Where do you go? To a local retail pharmacy, of course. Now, with the pharmacy network and your PAI identification card, you can enjoy the convenience of local pharmacy service at the discounted network pricing for your prescription drug needs. PAI has contracted with Caremark to administer your pharmacy benefits.

Selecting a pharmacy

With the pharmacy plan, there are certain advantages to using a network pharmacy, such as discounted prices and no claim forms to file. Locating a participating pharmacy is easy! There are thousands of participating pharmacies nationwide ready to serve you.

To locate a participating pharmacy, refer to your participating pharmacy directory or visit the Caremark section of our Web site at www.paisc.com. If you don't see your pharmacy listed, check first with your pharmacy to see if it has been added to the network since the list was printed. Also, you may call Caremark toll-free at 1-888-963-7290 to see if your pharmacy is in the network or to find the nearest participating pharmacy. Always check with your pharmacy to see if it is part of our network.

The benefits of using a participating pharmacy

You'll have NO claim forms to file and NO waiting for reimbursement if you use a participating pharmacy. At participating pharmacies, the pharmacist will use a computer to check your eligibility for benefits and determine the discounted cost of your prescription. If you **DON'T** present your ID card at a participating pharmacy, you won't save as much money, you'll have to file a claim form, and you may be reimbursed at a lower level.

How to use the Retail Drug Card Pharmacy Program at:

Participating Pharmacies:

1. Show your ID card and prescription(s) to the pharmacist.
2. Your pharmacist will tell you the correct copayment amount to pay.
3. There are no claim forms to file!

Non-participating Pharmacies:

1. Pay the full amount of the prescription and file a claim form.
2. Mail your completed and signed claim form with the prescription drug receipt to:

Your reimbursement check should arrive within 10-14 days from the day you send your claim form. You will be reimbursed according to your schedule of benefits.

Request generics to save money

Generic drugs are lower-priced therapeutic equivalents to more expensive brand-name drugs. Generic drugs must meet the same high standards established by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for purity, safety, strength and effectiveness. Ask your doctor to allow a generic substitution when one is available.
